TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN

Concerning the recognition of federations for the Chinese Martial Arts. The World Governing body is the International Wushu Federation (IWUF). The IWUF is recognised by the International Olympic Committee (IOC).

The IWUF Constitution only allows for one federation to be recognised within a country, and that federation must be a national federation, which should be recognised by or working towards being recognised by their National Olympic Committee (NOC) or government sports administration.

Any individual person, club, association or other group that participates in or claims to participate in the Chinese martial arts should make every effort to join the IWUF official body in their country if they wish to be involved in IWUF activities.

As far as the IWUF is concerned only those in Membership of the IWUF can be considered as officially representing our sport at national or international level as maybe recognised by the IOC or their respective NOC.

Any group or others claiming any titles or responsibility in the Chinese martial arts outside of the IWUF do so in their own name and have no association with the IWUF or its Continental Bodies or Member Countries and are therefore not recognised by the IOC world body for Chinese martial arts the IWUF.
