3. Entry requirements

In low level Shaolin Gongfu categories only the members of the International and the Hungarian Chan Wu Federation can enter. In advanced Shaolin Gongfu, Wushu, Taiji and Sanda categories the competition is open to non member countries and associations.

Last date for entry: 12:00h Sunday 3rd October, 2010.

Entry on the spot is not acceptable!

Other entry requirements:

- a) Official membership card
- b) Valid Medical permission
- d) Fill in the entry form on www.gongfu.hu/ until 3rd October, 2010.
- e) Pay in the entry fee on 8th October, 2010. at the location of the competition.
- f) Accept and comply with the rules and regulations of the competition.

Association membership card and medical permission must be presented at the registration. The verification of age is on the basis of membership card or passport. Classification into age-groups is on the basis of birth year.

Competitors enter into the actual categories on their own responsibility. In case of any kind of injury the Competition Committee decline responsibility, and claiming for compensation is not possible.

The Organising Committee will not be held responsible for any injuries endured during the competition.

Competing in Sanshou and Qinda categories can only be allowed following a medical examination on the location of the competition.

ATTENTION!

The competitors are kindly asked not to leave their valuables unattended as the Competition Committee doesn't take the responsibility of the loss of anything.

The Competition Committee will not be held responsible for any damage in private property, so we kindly ask everyone to take care of their personal belongings.

4. Entry and drawing-lots

Each category is separated into men and women categories considering the groups of ages. Minimum 4 participants should be in each category, otherwise categories will be merged.

(*2) Shaolin Chung Hop Kuen 37 movements, Shaolin Shi Ba Lo Han Quan, and other southern forms with the same length. In this beginner category only those participants can take part who are members of International Chan Wu Federation and are on the second student level (or under). Those who take part in these categories cannot take part in open categories except for Group demonstration category.

(*3) Shaolin Chung Hop Kuen 67 movements, and other southern forms with the same length. In this beginner category only those participants can take part who are members of International Chan Wu Federation and are on the third student level (or under). Those who take part in these categories cannot take part in open categories except for Group demonstration category.

(*5) In this category different groups compete with each other. Each group has maximum 10 minutes to perform with no member limit. Music can be used. The performance can include any single or group barehand or weapon forms, choreographed fights or qi gong.

8. Prize

Group demonstration category: I., II., III. places receive 1 medal per team, and each team-member receives diploma.

Extra prize: the most successful and the most scientific competitor receives medals diplomas and the extra prizes of our sponsors.

9. Entry tickets for spectators

Entry is free for the competitors, their access is ensured by the prior registration.
